

Student Rides and Pick-Up Policy

It is expected at the conclusion of any event, activity, field trip, or school performance, that students will be picked up from school property in the following manner;

1. For any band performance, band activity, or band event held on school property (except normal or regular after school rehearsals), student must be picked up by a parent or other responsible party designated by parent within **30** minutes after the conclusion of the event or specified conclusion time indicated in the informational flyer distributed before the event (which ever is sooner).
2. Upon the return of the band to school property from a parade, festival, or other event not on school property, student must be picked up within **30** minutes of our arrival home or the designated time specified in the informational flyer distributed before the event (which ever is sooner).

The following consequences may result if student is not picked up in a timely fashion as described above;

1. Any student picked up after the **30** minute waiting limit may be restricted from any or all performances, activities, or events in the future. *Grades could be affected as the result of being restricted from concerts, activities, and events. Grading policy will be observed according to the class syllabus. Students may be given alternate assignments to compensate for missing performances and activities.*
2. If the **30** minute limit has been reached and a student is unable to communicate with the person designated to pick them up from any of the above described events, **the school Principal or the Principal's designee will be contacted.** The Principal will then decide action(s) to be taken if it becomes necessary.

It is reasonable to assume that in the case of an emergency on the part of the driver designated to pick up the student, that the student will be supervised until released to a responsible person or the school Principal. *If there is an serious emergency* - please contact your child or the sheriff dispatch ASAP so they can notify the Principal.

If in the case of an emergency by the pick up driver, every effort should be made by the driver of the student waiting, to contact that student informing them of why they will be beyond the pick up time limit. Additionally, every effort will be made in the case of a late pick up to contact the designated driver of that student before the Principal is contacted, but not beyond what has been described above.
